Data, Data, Data

- Data Act Requirements
 - Reviewing quarterly for FPDS/USA Spend/Financial System synchronization
 - Certification Required for data act and FPDS
- More Data Calls
 - Data verification
 - Metrics
 - Cyber Security
 - FITARA

Budget Cuts

- First pass Presidential Budget
 - Small agencies up for closure
 - Several large agencies targeted for big reductions
 - Build up of military and homeland security
- What it means to us:
 - Sharper pencils in negotiating
 - Streamlining internal expenses
- What can you do to help?
 - Complete package & dedicated resources

Centers of Excellence

- Old term making a resurgence
- What does it mean?
 - Potentially that certain areas within government will be designated “best in class” and be given authority to buy across government
 - This fits well into the shared service model that we currently provide

Category Management

- Further standardization of common services and products will be promoted
- Large buys will be used to leverage better terms and pricing
- Current examples include:
 - Desktop/Laptops
 - Office Supplies
 - Cyber Products

Reduction in Policy

- Responses are in process now to a request from OMB for suggestions to reduce policies and procedures that affect the acquisition cycle.
- Treasury has submitted an extensive list of items

Memorandum –M -17-22

- What does this mean for acquisitions?
 - Mandatory use of Best-in-Class (BIC) vehicles (agencies must demonstrate how they will increase the spend under BIC)
 - Review of existing IT Services Contracts to assess and potentially eliminate duplication
 - Impact on future acquisition strategies
 - Customer education
 - Business case (with actual data) to support why a requirement can not be awarded under BIC, GWAC, etc.
